Essentials of Fire Chaplaincy (Basic Level 100) Class The Essentials of Fire Chaplaincy is a 16 hour course introduced to the fire service chaplaincy. The Essentials of Fire Chaplaincy is the basic level 100 course for fire service chaplains; a foundational study upon which all other chaplaincy courses are built. The Essentials class is designed to train newly appointed fire chaplains, as well as veteran chaplains seek a refresher to update their information and skills.

Program Highlights

- An introduction, foundation and history of the fire chaplaincy and the history of the Federation of Fire Chaplains.
- The Personhood of the Chaplain is WHO you are as a fire chaplain.
- The Ministry to Firefighters is WHAT you do as a fire chaplain.
- Beginning a Fire Chaplaincy is HOW to develop your fire chaplaincy program.
- Chaplain Operations on the emergency scene is HOW YOU OPERATE as a fire chaplain on the scene.
- Chaplaincy Ministry to Crisis Victims is HOW you do and don't do with crisis victims.
- Overview of CISM is an overview of the CISM process (only introduction).
- Injury and Death Notification is HOW to do and NOT TO DO with this important task.
- Introduction to Firefighter Funeral gives you funeral customs, types, and how you can make a difference with families when a firefighter is honored when honor is due.
- HIPAA, Confidentiality, PSOB, and EPA are other important information you need as you assist firefighters and their families.

This 16 hour (two-day schedule) class is the foundational component upon your advanced fire chaplain training. After completion of this class, you are encouraged to work toward your Advanced Chaplaincy (130+ hours) of training and experience. The next step is to complete the Application for the FFC Training Institute and become a member of FFC. Initial FFC dues are \$125.00 which sets up your training records and tracks your training.
